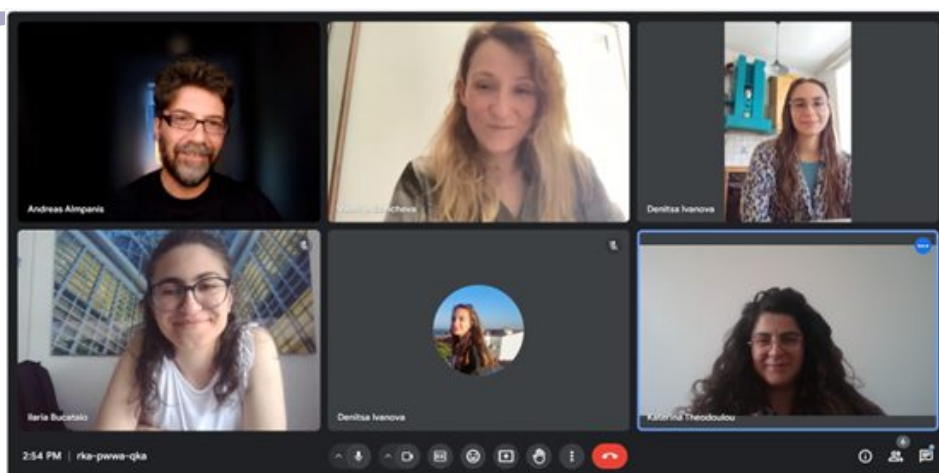

What's happened so far?

Small-Scale Data Review and Analysis

A Small-Scale Data Review and Analysis has been completed and reported on. The report includes all the findings from the five desktop research efforts conducted in the relevant countries of the POWER UP project consortium (Bulgaria, Austria, Greece, Cyprus, and Italy), which aim to crucially support the development of entrepreneurship education material for young adults with special education needs (SEN).

Questionnaires

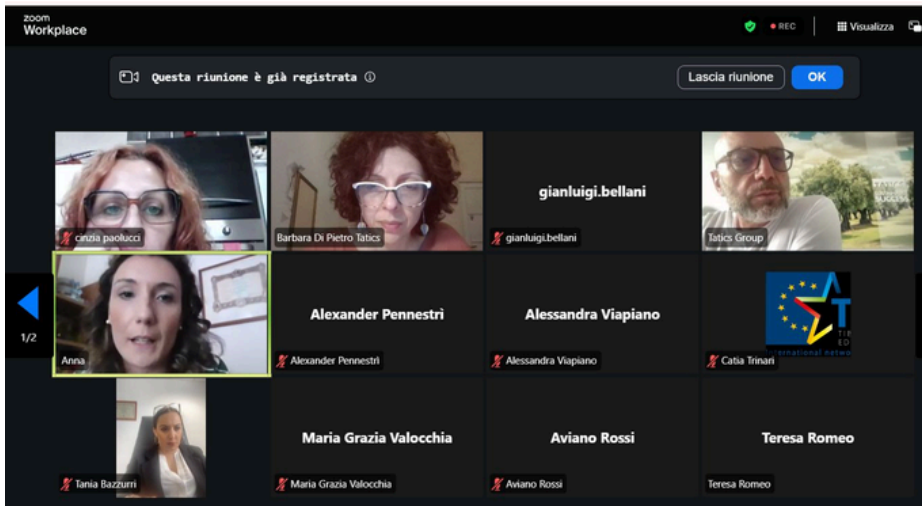
A Questionnaire was designed to capture the unique insights of professionals working with SEN youth and distributed after the focus group meetings. The questionnaire seeks to gather insights from professionals working with youth with special educational needs in order to further support the development of the education material - in addition to the desk research.

Focus Groups

Focus Group meetings took place online and on-site as part of the activities of Work Package 3. On 23 April 2024, the first focus group took place in Larissa/Greece, under the coordination of iED, with the participation of 9 professionals. Additionally, 2 more focus groups took place online, for Italy and Cyprus, on 16 May 2024 and 12 June respectively. Tatics hosted the focus group in Italy, wherein 14 experts participated, and Enoros Consulting hosted the one in Cyprus, with the participation of 3 experts respectively.

Info Days have taken place in Austria, Greece and Cyprus with the aim to inform participants of the PowerUP! Project and its upcoming activities. An Info Day event will take place in Italy on 27 June 2024.
