Through a series of high-quality entrepreneurial-focused resources and training modules, freely accessible and tailored to the learning needs of young adults with SEN, "PowerUP!" seeks to equip participants with the necessary skills to navigate and succeed in today's digital landscape, fostering inclusion, and opening up new opportunities for personal and professional growth.

The project partners have organised dissemination events and have made the website available in all partner languages. They have also finalised the Small-Scale Data Review and Analysis Report (A1) and the Needs Identification and Module Design (A2) Report. The partners are now working on the microlearning modules and scripts for the instructional material which will be ready an available in early 2025.



National Pilot Workshops Delivered

Partners across Bulgaria, Cyprus, Austria, Greece, and Italy successfully conducted pilot workshops with educators, trainers, and young people. These pilots tested the full Power Up curriculum and gathered valuable feedback to improve the materials.
















Thank You and Farewell from the PowerUP! Project Team!
