The "PowerUP!" project is an innovative initiative designed to empower young adults with special educational needs by enhancing their digital and entrepreneurial skills.

Through a series of high-quality entrepreneurial-focused resources and training modules, freely accessible and tailored to the learning needs of young adults with SEN, "PowerUP!" seeks to equip participants with the necessary skills to navigate and succeed in today's digital landscape, fostering inclusion, and opening up new opportunities for personal and professional growth.

The project partners have organised dissemination events and have made the website available in all partner languages. They have also finalised the Small-Scale Data Review and Analysis Report (A1) and the Needs Identification and Module Design (A2) Report. The partners are now working on the microlearning modules and scripts for the instructional material which will be ready an available in early 2025.



Key Milestones

WP3 - Microlearning Modules Completed

We are proud to announce the completion of Work Package 3 (WP3), which focused on developing a comprehensive training course made up of six microlearning modules, tailored specifically to the needs of young adults with SEN. These modules were designed following extensive research and consultations through desk research, interviews, and stakeholder input. Each module includes three units, engaging video content, and support materials for educators. All content has been finalised in English and is now being translated into all partner languages, ensuring accessibility and cultural relevance across all consortium countries.

Here's a snapshot of what each module covers:

- **Module 1:** Inclusion and Teaching of Entrepreneurship in Mainstream Education Covers the role of entrepreneurship in social cohesion, community building, and its integration into formal and informal education.
- **Module 2**: Smooth Integration of Young Adults with SEN Focuses on recognising the strengths of youth with SEN, creating inclusive learning spaces, and promoting social-emotional empowerment.
- **Module 3:** Teaching Entrepreneurship to Youth with SEN Offers adaptable teaching methods, strategies to value individual strengths, and simulation-based approaches to learning.
- **Module 4**: Youth Entrepreneurship The How-To Emphasises sustainable entrepreneurship, creative thinking, and the use of digital tools for business growth.
- **Module 5**: Core Entrepreneurial Skills and Competencies Covers market navigation, employment options, and essential financial literacy.
- **Module 6**: The Art of Creative Thinking and Problem-Solving Focuses on building creative thinking skills and applying them to generate solutions.




